ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES

10 A.M. SUNDAY MORNINGS

Inquirers Class Are you new to Lebanon Presbyterian Church? This class will give an overview of who we are and what we understand to be our God-given purpose. This six week class begins on October 11.

"S. A. L. T." (Single Adults Learning Together! Meets in Room 309.) A class just for the single individual! It is led by Jim and Ellen Albright and operates as a fellowship, a ministry, a small group and a learning opportunity.

"Faith Explorers" (Meets in Room 305.) This class, led by Gary Ensing, is a group of adults of all ages who meet in a fun and relaxed setting to fellowship with each other and to explore the Word of God.

Adult "Bible in Life" Class (Meets in Room 306.) This is a Bible study with much opportunity for discussion and participation. Participants discover how to apply the Bible to their daily lives.

"Faith Weavers" (Meets in Room 102.) This class, led by Jim and Rosie VanDeGrift, is for all adults regardless of age or marital status. It is deeply Bible-based and life application oriented, with open discussion.

"Parents of Teens" (Meets in Room 313) Focuses on issues of interest for anyone with a teen or emerging teen in their home. It is facilitated by Cathy Riggan and Nona McCauley.

Creation vs. Evolution (Meets in Room 311) Most evolutionary thoughts directly conflict with Creation and the Bible to a point that most experts say you must believe in one or the other. Christians need to be aware of the arguments that exist, what they mean to Christianity, and what the proof is for these arguments. In "Creation vs. Evolution", we will explore four lines of thought. We invite anyone regardless of current beliefs to come. Should be high school age or older to attend. Led by Nathan Sorum.
