INVITING THE HOLY SPIRIT TO BE ACTIVE AT LPC

This week, our focus shifts to the Holy Spirit, the Comforter and Guide. We invite you to join us in daily prayer, seeking a deeper encounter with the Holy Spirit. May our lives be filled afresh with His presence and power. As we open ourselves to the Spirit's work, anticipate transformation and a renewed sense of purpose. Let us be a church where the Holy Spirit is welcomed and active in our midst.

Instructions:

Begin each day by inviting the Holy Spirit into your time of prayer.

Meditate on the scriptures provided to deepen your understanding.

Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit in your life and in the church.

Be attentive to any promptings or guidance from the Holy Spirit.

SUNDAY, JANUARY 21 - Inviting Prayer

- Read Luke 11:9-13. Ask God for His Holy Spirit to be present with you. Invite the Holy Spirit to search you and convict you. Repent and seek the Lord's grace in Jesus Christ.
- •Invite the Holy Spirit to be active and present with us at LPC. Pray that the Holy Spirit will begin a new work at LPC.

MONDAY, JANUARY 22 - Daily Surrender

- Pray through Galatians 5:22-23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control."
- Pray for a fresh filling of the Holy Spirit in lives of LPC members.
- Pray that God would work out the fruit of the flesh at LPC and we would see the growth of the fruit of the Spirit all around LPC.

TUESDAY, JANUARY 23 - God Knows Our Grief

- Pray using Romans 8:26 "Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words."
- During times of change most people experience some kind of grief. Grief is our natural emotional reaction to loss. We may not realize how the changes at LPC are affecting us but the Spirit is still interceding for us.
- Invite the Spirit into your pain and discomfort surrounding this time of change at LPC.

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 24 - Spiritual Gifts

- Reflect on 1 Corinthians 12:7 "Now to each one, the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good."
- God is working in your heart through the Spirit to form you into the likeness of Jesus. The more we are like Jesus the more we see His grace and peace in our relationships. The more our minds have the mindset of Christ (Philippians 2) the more we will become the church LPC is called to be for God's glory. God will use each of our spiritual gifts to grow edify the body.
- Pray the Spirit to work out the spiritual gifts we need for His glory. Ask for discernment in using spiritual gifts for the church's benefit.

THURSDAY, JANUARY 25 - Personal Transformation

- Pray through Romans 12:2 "Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."
- •There's so many ways to be lead astray these day. Our culture makes us into little selfish consumption machines. We are so easily tricked into serving deaf and blind idols of entertainment, comfort and preference.
- You are one member of a larger body at LPC. Who you are and what you do (or don't do) effects the health of the LPC body. Open up your heart and ask God to make you more like Jesus. Confess your selfishness and cast down your idols.
- Seek guidance on areas of personal growth and sanctification.

FRIDAY, JANUARY 26 - Boldness in Faith

- Pray using Acts 4:31 "After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly."
- The disciples weren't special. They were ordinary. The disciples didn't go to Bible school or seminary. They were gifted with the Holy Spirit. Every believer has that same gift. The spirit of boldness that moved in the disciples is waiting in you. Don't wait for a professional Christian church employee to share the Gospel. All God is calling you to do is: "Share the Truth that you know." Share your story of God working in your life. The blind man says simply "I was blind but now I see." Pray that God will use your testimony of faith for His Glory.
- Ask for boldness in sharing the Gospel and living out one's faith.

SATURDAY, JANUARY 27 - A Waiting Prayer

- Summarize the week with a prayer using Ephesians 3:16-17a "I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith."
- Pray with a spirit of expectancy for the upcoming weeks.
- Tell God that you are waiting on Him. Tell Him that you are ready for what He's going to do next in your life and in the life of our LPC family.
