SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 4 - Overview of Ministries

- Pray using 1 Corinthians 15:58 "Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain."

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 5 - Church Leadership - EPC Denomination, Pastors, Elders, Deacons, Staff

- Pray through James 3:17 "But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then
 peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere."
- Our church is Presbyterian, part of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC), emphasizing shared leadership, accountability, and a connectional structure with elected elders overseeing congregations nationwide.
- Pray and thank God for EPC ties, interconnectedness, and relational ties. Pray individually for the Pastors, Elders, Deacons and Staff individually by name at lebanonpresbyterian. org/leadership. Pray for wisdom, discernment, and a commitment to Scripture.

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 6 - Volunteers and Servants

- Reflect on Matthew 23:11 "The greatest among you will be your servant."
- •Thank God for volunteers and servants within the church. Pray for the volunteers in each ministry area found on the lebanonpresbyterian.org/leadership page. Consider "Prayer Walking" around the church.

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 7 - Family, Student, Children's Ministries and Pre-School

- Pray using Psalm 127:3 "Children are a heritage from the Lord, offspring a reward from him."
- Pray for the Parents, Teachers, Leaders, Volunteers, Teens, Young Adult and Children in our ministries. Pray for the ministry to them. Pray for God to bless us with more opportunities to share Jesus with young families.
- Pray for our new pastor, Rev Jeff Moore, to be able to relate to the various generations and cultures represented in our church.
- Pray and focus on the Focus on the specific needs of youth and children.

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 8 - Worship Team

- Pray through Psalm 100:2-4 "Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture."
- Pray for God to bless our worship team with godly leadership, unity, and dependence on Your power. Guard them from pride, cultivate gratitude, and provide rest and rejuvenation.

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 9 - Mission, Outreach and Play-School Ministries

- Pray using Matthew 28:19-20 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you."
- Pray for divine guidance, wisdom, and a united spirit in mission and outreach. Lift up prayers for strength, endurance, transformative impact, and effective evangelism. Pray for the impact of outreach ministries in the community.

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 10 - Closing Prayer

- Summarize the week with a prayer using 1 Peter 4:10 "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms."
- How might God be calling you to grow in service and using your gifts? Are you a faithful steward? Pray and ask God to show you.
