Located between the Ark and the Welcome Center, our nursery provides a warm, loving, and safe environment for children. Also, next to our Welcome Center and connected to our nursery, we offer a Family Room, with a TV for watching the worship service.

These classes journey chronologically through the Bible, learning about God and His great love for them and how their learning in class can be applied to their lives.

This class delves into deep topics that preteens begin to have as they strive to make their faith their own. Each week, they will discuss a hard-to-answer faith question and examine what the Bible says about it.

Vintage is an intergenerational fellowship open to teens, parents, young adults, and people of all ages, where generations grow together in faith and discuss how God's truth engages today's culture.

This class, for all adults, is deeply Bible-based and life application-oriented, with open discussion.

Seeking Adults Learning Together. This class is a fellowship that welcomes adult singles and couples of all ages to join in learning opportunities to feed our faith. We involve our group in studies about current life issues and how we should live and learn by following Jesus Christ's example.

Bible-in-Life promotes community and challenges each person to grow spiritually and to apply Bible-based lessons to their own lives in a meaningful way. All are welcome! Led by Jim Garrett.

This group is designed to support and encourage parents in the stages of their parenting journey. We gather to explore biblical principles, share experiences, and grow together in faith and parenting. Led by John Untener.
