**MAUNDY THURSDAY, April 17 at 6:00 p.m. in the Ark.** Gather for dinner with friends in the intimacy of the Upper Room. Worship and dinner are intertwined in this service. **LEBANON COMMUNITY CROSS WALK, Good Friday, April 18 at 10:45 a.m. starting at St. Francis De Sales Catholic Church.** This silent 1.5 mile silent procession behind the cross will end at Pleasant Square Park by the Post Office by 12:15 p.m. Scripture will be read along the way.
